Information on the collection and disposal of ship waste in Austria

Environmentally sound handling of ship waste

Avoiding pollution of soil, air and water requires an environmentally sound handling of ship wastes in accordance with the following principles:

- Waste prevention whenever possible
- Recycling of wastes whenever possible
- Environmentally friendly handling and disposal of non-recyclable waste

Disposal Infrastructure in Austria

Along the Austrian stretch of the Danube, **cargo vessels** can dispose of their ship waste at the collection facilities provided in ports, or a collection service can be arranged upon request.

In addition, via donau – Österreichische Wasserstraßen-Gesellschaft mbH provides collection containers for recyclables and residual waste free of charge for cargo vessels at 3 locks.

For **passenger vessels**, collection facilities are available at passenger landing stages and winter ports. Where necessary, some operators can arrange waste handover services.

Sport boats and **pleasure crafts** can use the available disposal facilities in marinas.



Free disposal facilities for residual waste and recyclable materials are available to **cargo vessels** at the following locks:


These facilities are exclusively for **cargo vessels**.
The following waste types can be disposed of free of charge at the locks:

-  residual waste
-  clear glass
-  waste paper
-  coloured glass

 plastic/metal packaging

 Hazardous waste and problematic substances such as waste oil, batteries, rechargeable batteries, paints, etc. must not be disposed of at the collection points at the locks. For cargo vessels, disposal options are available at some ports.
